SPECIAL TRADE REGULATION FOR «WINE PRODUCTS»

ARTICLE 1

Scope of Regulation – Category of tradable products

1) Primary products :

- Grapes
- Raisins
- Grapemust (grape syrup)
- Vine leaves

2) Processed products :

- Vinegar
- Distilled spirits
- Raki
- Ouzo
- White wine
- Wine red
- Rosé wine
- Sparkling wine
- Vermouth
- Aromatic wines

ARTICLE 2

Quality characteristics

1. The products covered by this Regulation shall comply with the requirements of Regulations (EU): (EC) No. 1493/1999 (on the common organization of the

market in wine) and (EEC) No . 2676/1990 (establishing Community methods of analysis applicable to wine). Also, those products must be in accordance with Regulation (EU) No. 543/2011 (laying down detailed rules for the application of the Council Regulation (EC) No. 1234/2007 in respect of the fruit and vegetables and processed fruit and vegetables sectors), as amended by the (EU) No. 701/2012 Implementing Regulation and with the Regulation (EC) no. 1234/2007 ("Single Regulation" establishing a common organization of agricultural markets and on specific provisions for certain agricultural products) as amended by Regulation (EC) no. 491/2009 and Regulation (EU) no. 513/2010. Further products should be in line with Regulation (EC) no. 510/2006 (on protection of geographical indications and designations of origin for agricultural products and foodstuffs).

2. In case of products derived from organic farming are applicable the provisions of Regulation (EC) No. 834/2007 (on organic production and labeling of organic products) which repealed Regulation (EEC) No. 2092/91 and Regulation (EU) No . 354/2014 amending and correcting points of Regulation (EC) No. 889/2008 on the application of Regulation (EC) No. 834/2007.
3. In case of products with a protected "designation of origin" or protected "geographical indication" are applicable the provisions of Regulation (EU) No. 1151/2012 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 21 November 2012 (on quality schemes for agricultural products and foodstuffs), which replaced Regulation (EC) No. 510/2006 of March 20, 2006.
4. In the case of other non-mandatory certification of products or processes reference will be made to the specific legal instruments and to relevant with the certification documents issued by the relevant certification body.

ARTICLE 3

Information Circular of Products

In the information circular the following required fields should be completed with respect to:

A. The characteristics of product quality :

- i. The month or months of production,
- ii. The exact place of production,
- iii. Elaboration,
- iv. Cultivation method,
- v. The size of the package,
- vi. Names and / or trademarks,
- vii. Certification bodies and numbers and
- viii. Other information,
- ix. Other features

B. The method of execution of the contract :

- i. Time and method of payment,
- ii. Delivery and receipt Specifications,
- iii. Settlement of disputes

ARTICLE 4

Final provisions

The conditions and rules set out in this Special Regulation may be amended from time to time. In this case, the participants shall adequately inform users through their website.
