SPECIAL TRADE REGULATION FOR «DAIRY PRODUCTS»

ARTICLE 1

Scope of Regulation – Category of tradable products

This Regulation covers processed dairy products namely:

- Milk
- Cream
- Butter
- Dairy spreads
- Cheese
- Feta PDO
- Ariani
- Kefir
- Yogurt
- Gruyere cheese
- Parmesan
- Manouri
- paskitan
- Parcharotyr
- Anthotyros
- Kaseri PDO
- Rice pudding
- Ice cream

ARTICLE 2

Quality characteristics

1. The products covered by this Regulation shall comply with the requirements of Regulations (EU): (EC) No. 852/2004, (EC) No. 853/2004, (EC) No. 854 / 2004, (EC) No. 884/2004 ("hygiene package"): (EC) No. 2073/2005 (on microbiological criteria applicable to foodstuffs, including milk and its derivatives), (EC) No. 2074/2005 (security controls), (EC) No. 2076/2005 (on the "hygiene package" for the transitional provisions relating to the application of the Regulations of the European Parliament and of the Council (EC) No. 853/2004, (EC) No. 854/2004 and (EC) No. 882/2004 and the amendment of the Regulation (EC) No. 853/2004 and (EC) No. 854/2004), of Regulation (EC) No. 178/2002 (laying down the general principles and requirements of food law), of Regulation (EC) No. 882/2014 (on official controls), Regulation (EC) No. 1881/2006 (maximum levels for certain contaminants) of Regulation (EEC) No. 2377/90 (residues of medicinal products), of Regulation (EC) no. 1234/2007 of 22/10/2007 ("Uniform Regulations "establishing a common organization of agricultural markets and on specific provisions for certain agricultural products), of Regulation (EC) No. 1255/1999 (on the CMO for the milk sector and dairy products, as last amended by Regulation (EC) no. 1152/2007),) and Regulation (EU) no. 1308/2013 of December 17, 2013 (establishing a common organization of agricultural markets).
2. With respect to labeling, presentation and advertising of foodstuffs: Instructions (EEC) No. 395/1989 and (EC) No. 396/1989 with any amendments, Regulation (EU) No. 102/1993, Instructions (EC) No. 54/1994 and (EC) No. 21/1996, flying amending Directive (EEC) No. 112/1979, Directive (EC) no. 4/1997 amending Directive (EC) No. 112/1979), Regulation (EU) No. 10/1999, Regulation (EU) No. 13/2000, Instructions (EC) no. 89/2003 and (EC) no. 63/2005 (regarding indication of the ingredients present in foodstuffs), Regulation (EU) No. 41/2004 (on controls on food safety and the implementation of EU regulations in the same field), Directive (EC) no. 89/2003 (to allergens), and all amendments, additions and applications for that matter.
3. In case of products with a protected "designation of origin" or protected "geographical indication" are applicable the provisions of Regulation (EU) No.

1151/2012 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 21 November 2012 (on quality schemes for agricultural products and foodstuffs), which replaced Regulation (EC) No. 510/2006 of March 20, 2006.

4. In the case of other non-mandatory certification of products or processes reference will be made to the specific legal instruments and to relevant with the certification documents issued by the relevant certification body.

ARTICLE 3

Information Circular of Products

In the information circular the following required fields should be completed with respect to:

A. The characteristics of product quality :

- i. The month or months of production,
- ii. The exact place of production,
- iii. Elaboration,
- iv. Cultivation method,
- v. The size of the package,
- vi. Names and / or trademarks,
- vii. Certification bodies and numbers and
- viii. Other information,
- ix. Other features

B. The method of execution of the contract :

- i. Time and method of payment,
- ii. Delivery and receipt Specifications,
- iii. Settlement of disputes

ARTICLE 4

Final provisions

The conditions and rules set out in this Special Regulation may be amended from time to time. In this case, the participants shall adequately inform users through their website.
